The Front Royal-Warren County Anti-Litter Council is conducting its annual awards program for educational and community service projects related to keeping the community free of litter and educating students about the 3 "R's": **Reducing, Reusing, and Recycling/Upcycling**.

You will find attached a report form, a list of potential projects to stir your imagination, and a copy of the criteria forms for judging. Projects must have been conducted between August 1st, 2017 and April 30th, 2018 to be eligible. If your organization wishes to participate, please complete the report form and submit your projects to our office. Report forms and projects shall be due by Monday April 30th, 2018 @ 5:00PM.

Project judging criteria vary between the Educational and Civic organizations but creativity, content, outreach and community impact play a big part in the judging of all projects that are submitted. Please be as detailed as possible in filling out the report form with supplemental information about your projects included as separate documents.

Please note that even if you are sending support material such as a scrapbook, pictures, news articles, etc., the report form must be completed. Please provide contact information so projects can be returned to the contestants.

Entries may be mailed to our attention at the address listed below or hand-delivered to the Warren County Government Center - Office of Planning and Zoning at 220 North Commerce Avenue, Suite 400, Front Royal, VA 22630 (we are located across from the Front Royal Post Office and Front Royal Fire Department).

## **EXAMPLES OF POTENTIAL PROJECTS**

- Develop an exhibit to educate others about the need to keep the community free of litter and the importance of recycling using photos, text and three dimensional items.
- ♣ Adopt a road or segment of highway in the County using the VDOT Adopt-a-Highway program or adopt a street through the Town's Adopt-a-Street program.
- **Develop** a series of news articles or video news reports concerning the importance of litter control and incorporate into blog for a website or newsletter.
- ♣ Write a children's book about recycling and have it printed for use with a children's group or school.
- **♣** Conduct an essay contest about litter control or recycling and how it affects our community and our world.
- Design and install a rain garden in a public area.
- ♣ Conduct a poster contest around the theme "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle".
- ♣ Make robots, musical instruments or other creatures with recycled items found in your home.
- **♣** Participate in the annual Town and County Clean-up Day event or assist at a designated collection site.
- ♣ Design an upcycling project with items found at yard sales, flea markets or around the house.
- **♣** Develop a puppet show about litter control and recycling and perform for students in your school.
- ♣ Start a recycling program at your school in conjunction with an outdoor clean-up day for the school property.
- **♣** Be creative and original and involve as many people as you can, and document the impact to your school and community.
- ♣ Develop a Web-blog, You-Tube video, or DVD of projects with members in action.
